On June 28, 2007 the U.S. Supreme Court ruled in a 5-4 decision to strike down school desegregation programs in Louisville and Seattle—effectively gutting the 1954 *Brown vs Board of Education* decision against school segregation. The majority was led by the Bush-appointed Chief Justice John Roberts, who was joined by Antonin Scalia, Samuel Alito, Clarence Thomas, and Anthony Kennedy.
