



1955, 60 years ago: Racists in Money, Mississippi, murder 14-year-old Emmett Till for whistling at a white woman. His murderers are set free, found not guilty of any crime.



2005, 10 years ago: After Hurricane Katrina floods and devastates New Orleans, local and national authorities leave Black people to die, with no food or water, or herd them into the Superdome like cattle. Black people working together to get food and water are shot as looters, as are those trying to cross the Danziger Bridge to escape the flood.
