



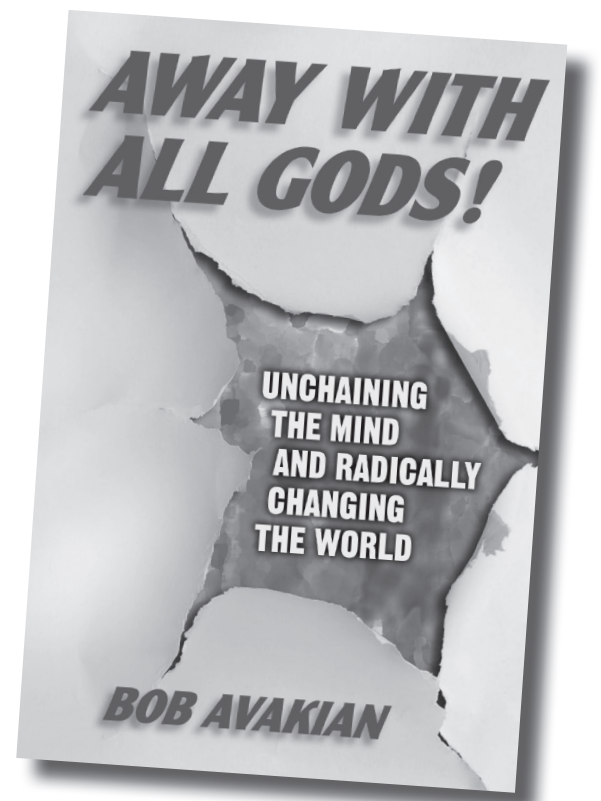

In October, the Ethical Humanist Society of Chicago (EHSC) took a shameful stand when they rescinded their long-standing invitation for Sunsara Taylor to speak on the topic "Morality Without Gods" to their weekly gathering. The decision sparked broad outrage. Sunsara announced publicly she would be attending the EHSC's Sunday gathering and giving the EHSC the opportunity to do the right thing and allow her talk to go forward, up until the last minute. But the president of the EHSC called the police, who brutalized and arrested a videographer (in photo at right) who was filming Sunsara as she made a statement
